Broker / Carrier Expectations:

1. Communicate with our Logistics Team through our TMS system, phone, and email in a timely manner.

2. Communicate with customers to schedule delivery appointments, when needed, and update the TMS system.

3. Notify us though the TMS system, phone, or email if there are any issues that may cause the delivery to not make the delivery appointment/window.

4. Process all billing through the TMS system.

5. Provide vehicles that are clean, dry and odor free as well as being safe, roadworthy, and able to handle the harsh conditions needed to transport roll paper. This means:

- Trailers must be in good condition and have a functional I.C.C. bumper.
- All trailers must be swept out before loading.
- Trailers cannot have any type of debris on the floor.
- There can be no moisture in the trailer and no daylight showing through holes or cracks in the walls, ceiling, or floor.
- Any nails sticking up out of the floor must be removed before loading can begin.
- Tandem axles must be able to function properly.
- All interior wear bands and walls must be in good condition and snag-free.
- Clamp truck weights are almost 17,000# and roll weights can reach 6,000# for a combined weight of up to 23,000# so all floors must be in good condition without any holes or major defects and should have a 24,000# rating.
